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## Statement

Inspired by the politics of the Anthropocene, my work tackles the complexities of contemporary human existence: investigating how the global impact of globalisation, consumerism and mutations interact with human behaviour change and alterations of the natural world.

Spanning video, photography and participatory installations, my artistic research articulates the borders between narrative and conceptual art.

I am known for re-configuring and re-contextualizing ordinary items of everyday consumption, placing particular emphasis on the creative process in which I often re-evaluate the artisanal tradition.

For my installations and performances I prefer the use of discarded materials, which highlight contradictory realities and their complex socio-political implications. I am mainly interested in the question of the social function of art with designs for new role models and lifestyles.
